In addition to outright gifts of cash, memorial giving can be accomplished with a bequest in a will, living trust or as a beneficiary designation of a financial account. Many people find such a gift to be very satisfying and meaningful way to memorialize or to honor their family or loved one.

In addition, some families have made arrangements with the Grant County Community Foundation to establish and place gifts into a donor-advised fund that honors the family and its ties to the community.
