


What is a Community Foundation

The Grant County Community Foundation Incorporated is a Kansas corporation with a 501(c)3 non-profit status that is organized as a public charity. We can:

- Accept donations to any existing fund in the foundation.
- Establish a fund in the foundation to support your charitable giving plan.
- Accept donations of:
 - Cash
 - Check
 - Credit Card
 - Stock, bonds and mutual funds
 - Commodities
 - Real Estate
 - Minerals
 - IRA's and other types of retirement accounts
- Donations can be accepted now and/or part of an estate plan.

^{**}Demand Funds allow both the principal and interest to be disbursed.

- Accept memorial donations that will be acknowledged to the family as well as the donor.
- Accept scholarship funds and handle the student applications.
