Jimmie married Loren Wayne Main September 28, 1953. Jimmie was employed at Grant County State Bank from 1952 to 1984, holding various positions becoming a Vice President in 1976. From 1984 – 1991 she was employed by Garden National Bank (Bank IV) in Garden City, Kansas. She returned to Ulysses in 1991 and was employed at Southwestern Bank until her retirement. Jimmie was past president of the State of Kansas National Association of Banking Women and Finney County Women's Chamber and a member of Downtown Association. She served on the Boards of

the Salvation Army Advisory Board, Tumbleweed Girl Scouts, and Crossroads Board of Directors.
